Study Location

The study is located at the intersection of Charles Road and Illinois 120/
Greenwood Road in McHenry County.









Purpose and Need

THE PURPOSE of the project is to address the safety concerns and reduce the potential of future severe crashes. The geometric deficiencies of substandard tapers, storage lengths, and cross-sectional elements within the intersection limits will be addressed.

THE NEED for the project is a result of the crashes experienced at the intersection that include rear-end, turning, and fixed object crashes. There were 31 total intersection related crashes between 2016 and 2020.















Existing Charles Road West Approach








Signalized Intersection

IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- North-South left turn lanes added on IL 120/Greenwood Road
- Removes eastbound acceleration lane, decreasing impervious area
- Shoulder and ditch widening
- Remove free flow northbound right turn


Typical Section - IL 120 South Approach


